I explained what a visit is like. "A portion of your appointment is private. That's when we fill out more of your intake, discuss your results, etc. For your privacy, we do that part without your guest. I will be your advocate and will walk you through things. Then your guest is welcome to join as we talk about all the resources we have to offer."

She said "Okay, I was gonna bring "the dad." Thanks!"

"He is welcome to come! We are "guy friendly." We even have resources just for men."

A client, we'll call "Lori received the offer to reschedule due to the storm. But Lori was eager to get in as quickly as possible.

You may remember what it was like. When a woman takes a home pregnancy test, and it appears positive, she is eager to get confirmation. The terrible weather didn't deter *Lori*!

After *Lori* got through the storm to the center, she heard, "We are here for you no matter what."

Lori received a lab-quality pregnancy test, an ultrasound scan, diapers, wipes, and ointment for her toddler. In addition to the material support and encouragement, *Lori* received the offer of our prayers.

We are so thankful for our dedicated volunteers and supporters. You warm the hearts of our clients! You warm our hearts, too! (The test did not yet show a viable pregnancy. *Lori* may have miscarried.)

Two days later, I texted her a reminder.

"Hi, I'm okay. I'm just nervous because his mom wants me to have an abortion."

"I am so sorry! That is so stressful! That's a lot of pressure for you right now!" I acknowledged her feelings and then assured her, "You know that legally no one has the right to force you to have an abortion. Your pregnancy will affect you differently than anyone else."

"Yes, that's my point! They can't understand how I feel!"

"I just want you to know that we are here for you! We want to give you the information and resources to make the best decision you can. An appointment is your best 'next step'. When and if you are comfortable with it, we can set up a meeting all together, if you want. You are stronger than you probably feel at this moment."

"Thanks, but I probably won't want her to come. Do you know if there's some way I can get insurance for my baby?"

We talked a little more about pregnancy tests, their accuracy, and when the best time is to take one. I sent her some medical resources and a link to get additional support and insurance from the state.

When *Shanna* came in we asked a few more questions and then administered the test. It was positive! We discussed more about her situation and her options.

Shanna seemed to have interest in parenting. By

invitation, the father of the baby came in partway through the consultation. Like many guys in that situation, he expressed shock and didn't have much to say. I reassured him and gave him some information and resources, too. I think he found us "guy friendly!"

The following week she texted again. "I finally told my mom. It was actually easier than I expected. Hey, is it okay to drink pineapple juice?"

"Yes, and be sure to study the info I sent about what's good to eat while you are pregnant!"

I texted her a few days later to follow up, and she responded with, "Hi! I'm doing great! I have an ultrasound scheduled in a couple of weeks."


